**A Resolution to Appoint a Claims Agent to receive
Claims for damages**

WHEREAS, R.C.W. 4.96.020, amended by Chapter 119, Laws of 2001 requires that the governing body of the entity formally appoint an agent to receive claim for damages.

WHEREAS, Kittitas County currently has a claims procedure, and claims are to be filed with the county auditor and to be distributed to the County Prosecutor, County Commissioners affected department and the insurance company, and;

WHEREAS, the County Prosecutor is responsible for the review and recommendation of approval or denial for each claim for damages. The recommendation forward to the Board of County Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kittitas County Board of County Commissioners hereby appoint the County Auditor to be the Claims Agent to receive the Claims for Damages for Kittitas County. This resolution must be recorded with the County Auditor.




