They too will be voicing their concern. I do not understand how you can continue to even consider this project in this area. I will support this type of facility in a commercial or industrial setting but not residential. This isn't a mom and pop slaughter house. This is a facility that will significantly decrease the valuations in the area.

There are enough people in the neighborhood outraged about this proposed business, that the commissioners should take note. This is not a way to garner votes in the next election and your voters will remember this.

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
