Also, water usage for this new proposed campground needs a second look. In 2012 we had to prove to the county that we had been using water on our land since 2008 because of the limitations

on water availability for irrigation from Lake CleElum to surrounding farmers' land. The increase of 30-90 adults camping in the area plus the lodge proposed for large gatherings, puts further strain on water supply for the area.
