SUBJECT: WDFW COMMENTS ON CU-23-00002 The Outpost

Dear Mr. Pederson,

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the CU-23-00002, The Outpost application, concerning the development of various recreation facilities including cabins, a lodge and associated facilities. Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) has reviewed the application and supporting documents. Our comments are regarding the project's impact on priority fish and wildlife habitats, particularly riparian habitats. Specifically, to ensure that if the application is approved that the development will not result in loss of Fish and Wildlife Habitat Conservation Areas (FWHCA) under Kittitas County Critical Areas Ordinance (CAO).

We appreciate that the updated site plan, dated October 16, 2023 correctly shows that the setback from Spring Creek is 150 foot and that all new facilities are located outside of this setback. If there are any further updates to the site plan, it is important that the setback from Spring Creek is maintained, including incorporation of any firewise setback as well. As Spring Creek is a fish-bearing stream, it is important to maintain the riparian area and that this proposal does not result in any loss of riparian area if approved.
