FORMAT FOR PLAYOFFS
 This is the third straight year of the current NFL playoff format, which includes the top seven teams from both the AFC and the NFC. The four division winners in both conferences automatically get the top four seeds, regardless of record, and then the top three teams with the best record that didn't win their division are the wild-card selections. That's why it's fairly common for a wild-card selection to have a better record—but worse playoff seeding—than a team that finished as a division winner. The No. 1-seeded team in each conference gets a bye into the second round—that's the Chiefs and Eagles—while No. 2 hosts No. 7, No. 3 hosts No. 6 and No. 4 hosts No. 5 during the wild-card weekend.
