Project Name: Bjorkman (ACU-20-00003)

Applicant: Jason Bjorkman, landowner.

Location: 1 parcel #12672, in a portion of Section 28, T18, R18, WM in Kittitas County, bearing Assessor's map numbers 18-18-28050-0001.

Proposed Project: Jason Bjorkman, landowner is proposing to use the existing shop as a Western Metal Products business facility and an additional 6 storage facilities for the businesses use, intended to be constructed in the future.

Written Comments on this proposal can be submitted to CDS any time prior to **5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 5, 2020**. This is an administrative conditional use permit request and does not involve a public hearing. Any person has the right to comment on this application and request a copy of the decision once made. Written comments submitted to the County regarding this application will be included in the public record in their entirety. All comments will be considered in the decision-making process, and any person has the right to comment on this application and receive notification of the Community Development Services administrative decision, once made. Appeals to an administrative land use decision may be filed within 10 working days with Kittitas County Community Development Services as outlined in Chapter 15A.07 of the Kittitas County Code. The current appeal fee is \$1550⁰⁰. Appeal procedures can vary according to the type of decision being appealed, and are described in Kittitas County Code, Title 15A.

Environmental Review (SEPA): The County expects to issue a Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) for this proposal, and will use the optional DNS process, meaning this may be the only opportunity for the public to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. Mitigation measures may be required under applicable codes, such as Title 17 Zoning and the Fire Code, and the project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an EIS is prepared. A copy of the threshold determination may be obtained from the County.
