Good morning, Kirk.

Yes, we received Neil's memo back in December. As I recall, we had a meeting scheduled with you, Neil and Jeff on December 22, 2010. We cancelled the meeting when we received the memo at 3:30 p.m. on December 21, 2010 because Neil chose to speak to us via the memo rather than meeting with us, which was the point of the meeting.

We deliberately avoided discussing the legal points in Neil's memo when we met with you and Jeff Watkins on February 3, 2011 because our goal at that meeting was to craft a collaborative solution with the County. That did not seem to be the appropriate venue for discussing the legal arguments since Neil again declined to attend. I did state for the record that we disagreed with the legal precedents cited in Neil's memo and with his conclusions.

One of the reasons we now want a meeting with Neil and you is to address the memo more specifically. A face-to-face meeting is preferable to a battle of the memos, although we would present a response in writing in advance of the meeting. We feel it is incumbent on Neil to meet with us to explain his position and his advocacy since our collaborative effort at an ordinance to resolve the issue was not supported by him.

I am puzzled by your request that we respond to the memo in writing when Neil told me on the phone on July 22nd that he was willing to meet. We are happy to provide the written response in preparation for a meeting as, again, that had been our plan. Here is my suggestion: Let's schedule the meeting for the earliest available date and Plum Creek will commit to providing the written response to Neil at least three business days in advance of the meeting.

As always, I am more than willing to speak or write to Neil directly rather than through you, but my phone calls are not being returned and that does not appear to be his preferred method of communication. I look forward to hearing from you.
