Dear Kirk

We represent Willowbrook Farms II LLC and Harrel Farm LLC. We are writing concerning two pending segregation applications, SG10-00021 and SG10-00022.

First, our clients insist that the County process these applications under the laws and regulations in effect on the date the applications were filed.

Second, it appears that the County is treating these applications, and these applicants, differently than other applicants and past applications. As an example, the County posted these applicant's approved and completed 2003 segregation when you have not posted other similar approved segregations, one of which is contiguous and others which are in close to our clients' properties. We also note you identified and highlighted in red online in a public domain one of the managers of these companies, when you did not do that for other segregation applicants.

We are putting you on notice that if you treat these applications and these applicants differently from other similarly situated persons and firms you are violating their civil and other legal rights and we reserve the right to pursue any and all remedies.
