Pursuant to RCW 36.70B, notice is hereby given that Kittitas County did, on January 28, 2008, receive a complete application from Sharon S. Finley, landowner, for a project specific rezone from Ag-20 to Ag-5 together with a Preliminary Plat proposing a total of 7-lots on approximately 40.18 acres of land. The subject property is located southeast of the City of Kittitas, off Sorenson Road, Ellensburg, WA 98926, and is located a portion of Section 29, T17N, R20E, WM, in Kittitas County. Written comments from the public may be submitted to Kittitas County CDS no later than Friday, March 28, 2008, after which a SEPA threshold determination will be issued pursuant to 43.21C RCW (State Environmental Policy Act) and WAC 197-11-355 (Optional DNS Process). This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of this proposal pursuant to SEPA, as a Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) is expected to be issued. A copy of this subsequent threshold determination will be available to the public upon request. This proposal may include, incorporate or require mitigation measures under applicable codes regardless of whether a Determination of Significance (DS) is issued and subsequent Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is prepared.
