Your application for a Shoreline Substantial Development Permit (SD-14-00001) which is for Phase 2A of the Interstate 90 Snoqualmie Pass East project between MP 59.5 and MP 62, located in a portion of Sections 1 & 12 of Township 21 N, Range 11 E, and Sections 10 and 15 of Township 21 N, Range 12 E, WM in Kittitas County, Washington has been determined complete as of Wednesday, August 6, 2014.

Continued processing of your application will include, but is not limited to, the following actions:

1. Posting of the property by the applicant is required along each street frontage. Signage may be obtained at the Community Development Services offices during regular business hours.
2. A Notice of Application will be published in the newspaper and sent to all adjoining property owners, governmental agencies, and interested persons.
3. Consideration of written comments from all adjoining property owners, governmental agencies, and interested persons.
4. Notification of a Public Hearing date.

You may pick up the "Land Use Action" signs at the CDS office during regular business hours to be posted as we discussed at the closest on/off ramps of the proposed project extents and return the signed affidavit of posting to my attention. Applicants are encouraged to provide photos of site posting with the signed affidavit of posting. After this has been completed I will be able to issue the Notice of Application.
