To whom it may concern,

I do not support Brown and Jackson (SE-20-00003). They cannot guarantee the positive, low impact promises expressed in their permit application.

We live near the silage ponds on Vantage Highway and some evenings in the summer, when the air cools, a gentle blanket of unpleasant silage smell rolls down over our home. It's very possible that would happen to the adjacent neighborhood near the proposed project. The wind can't be counted on to always blow away the inevitable smells.

There is currently an acceptable location for the disposal of Brown and Jackson waste at Rye Grass disposal site only few miles away from the proposed site. If they don't like paying county fees they can, as most businesses do, slightly raise the prices of their services to cover the fees.

One the project is installed and operational and there are adverse impacts voiced by local residents, a law suit might be the only way to address the issue. Please don't try to fix it if it isn't broken.
