Tax Parcel 295134 in the Parke Creek has become a site of interest with Brown and Jackson. The ponds are intended to retain large amounts of sewage from a wide variety of offsite sources.

This vicinity has seen a lot of growth since we moved here in 1987. My wife and I are preparing to retire and in an emergency, our land is where our money is.
