Proposal: Brown & Jackson, Inc. is proposing the construction of two storage ponds to hold septage that they pump from a variety of commercial and residential sources. The project is proposed on a site that is zoned Agricultural 20. The proposal is classified under Kittitas County Code (KCC) 17.61 as a "Utility". As proposed, these are permitted outright uses in the existing zone and land use designation.
