We have reviewed the proposed project and have the following comments.

- The subject property is adjacent to State Route 903 Spur (SR 903 SP), a Managed Access Class 3 highway with a posted speed limit of 45 miles per hour. Access to the subject property is currently via Airport Rd; direct access to SR 903 SP will not be permitted.
- Any proposed lighting should be directed down towards the site and away from SR 903 SP.
- Stormwater and surface runoff generated by this project must be retained and treated on site. Any discharge onto WSDOT right-of-way will require an approved Utility Permit.
- Any snow accumulated on the property shall not be moved onto WSDOT right-ofway. We encourage the proponent to not underestimate the potential for large volumes of snow and designate a snow storage area on the property.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Pre-Threshold Consultation for the construction of an 18,627 square foot self-storage building, proposed by Essen and Vicki Butler. We have reviewed the environmental checklist and have the following comment.

WATER RESOURCES

If you plan to use water for dust suppression at your project site, be sure that you have a legal right. In Washington State, prospective water users must obtain authorization from the Department of Ecology before diverting surface water or withdrawing ground water, with one exception. Ground water withdrawals of up to 5,000 gallons per day used for single or group domestic supply, up to 5,000 gallons per day used for industrial purposes, stock watering, and for the irrigation of up to one-half acre of non-commercial lawn and garden are exempt from the permitting process. Water use under the RCW 90.44.050 exemption establishes a water right that is subject to the same privileges, restrictions, laws and regulations as a water right permit or certificate obtained directly from Ecology. Temporary permits may be obtainable in a short time-period. The concern of Water Resources is for existing water rights. In some instances water may need to be obtained from a different area and hauled in or from an existing water right holder.

SEPA Application Comments

- Any grading over 100 cubic yards of material requires a grading permit. Any grading over 500 cubic yards of material will require engineered grading and storm water plans. See Kittitas County Code chapter 14.05.
- Engineered stormwater plans are required if the project generates an impervious surface exceeding 5000 square feet. The stormwater system will comply with the Stormwater Management Manual for Eastern Washington (SWMMEW).
- An access permit has been issued.
- This project is located within a FEMA-identified floodplain and will need to comply with KCC 14.08. Kittitas County has received a floodplain development permit application.
