ACCESS	1. An approved access permit shall be required from the Kittitas County
	Department of Public Works prior to creating any new driveway access or
	altering an existing access. Refer to Chapter 12 of the Kittitas County Code
	for access requirements.
	2. Maintenance of driveway approaches shall be the responsibility of the
	owner whose property they serve. The County will not maintain accesses.
	3. The applicant should be aware that any grading over 100 cubic yards of
	material will require a grading permit. Any grading could not occur until
	the SEPA process is complete and the grading permit is issued.
	4. Applicant should be aware that Driveways that are greater than or equal
	to 150' in length will require a fire apparatus turn around compliant with
	Appendix D of the International Fire Code and current Kittitas County
	Road and Driveway Standards.
	5. In addition to the above-mentioned conditions, all applicable Kittitas
	County Road Standards apply to this proposal. Access is not guaranteed to
	any existing or created parcel on this application.
