

Hello Jeremiah Cromie,

This consult is in reference to Miscellaneous SEPA Application – SE-23-00006 Snoqualmie Pass. This undertaking is located within the CCT Traditional Territories. We request any undertakings, particularly those involving ground disturbing activities, to have an IDP in place prior to implementation. This undertaking involves intense ground disturbing activities in the expansion and decommissioning of the wastewater treatment facilities adjacent to a major fresh water resource.

The proposed project lies within the traditional territory of the Wenatchi Tribe, 1 of the 12 constituent tribes of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation (CTCR), which is governed by the Colville Business Council (CBC). The CBC has delegated to the Tribal Historic Preservation Officer (THPO) the responsibility of representing the CTCR with regard to cultural resources management issues throughout the traditional territories of all of the constituent tribes under Resolution 1996-29. This area includes parts of eastern Washington, northeastern Oregon, the Palus territory in Idaho, and south-central British Columbia.

If ground disturbing activities are to be conducted, a cultural resource surface survey and subsurface testing of the area in and directly around the proposed ground disturbance are requested as a surface observation will not be an accurate assessment of the existent potential for sub-surface cultural deposits. Please do so prior to ground disturbing activities. These tests should be to the terminal depth of the implementation to ensure the totality of the presence or absence of cultural material. There are known cultural resources of historic and pre-contact significance nearby and the project APE is considered Very High Risk for an inadvertent discovery according to the DAHP predictive model. CCT H/A recommends that during implementation there be an inadvertent discovery plan or (IDP) in place to ensure compliance with all Section 106 and relevant cultural resource laws both federally and to the state of Washington. Previous surveys of the area have not included subsurface testing near the proposed APE and those surveys are all over a decade old.

We disagree with the SEPA checklist section 13. There are known sites evidencing Native American occupation of the area near the proposed APE. The sites have not been evaluated for eligibility and should be prior to implementation. Previous surveys were inadequate to assess the risk to cultural resources by this project. Tribes consider certain botanicals cultural resources and no ethnobotanical reviews have been conducted in the area. There are known traditional cultural properties nearby and as this project is projected to an extended duration of a few years terminating in 2025/2026, a broader cultural resource survey is requested.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment during the Optional Determination of Non Significance process for the Snoqualmie Pass Utility District Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements. We have reviewed the documents and have the following comments.

Water Resources

If you plan to use water for dust suppression at your project site, be sure that you have a legal right. In Washington State, prospective water users must obtain authorization from the Department of Ecology before diverting surface water or withdrawing ground water, with one exception. Ground water withdrawals of up to 5,000 gallons per day used for single or group domestic supply, up to 5,000 gallons per day used for industrial purposes, stock watering, and for the irrigation of up to one-half acre of non-commercial lawn and garden are exempt from the permitting process. Water use under the RCW 90.44.050 exemption establishes a water right that is subject to the same privileges, restrictions, laws and regulations as a water right permit or certificate obtained directly from Ecology. Temporary permits may be obtainable in a short time-period. The concern of Water Resources is for existing water rights. In some instances water may need to be obtained from a different area and hauled in or from an existing water right holder.
