

**NOTICE OF DECISION**  
**Berlin Zoning Setback Variance**  
**VA-19-00001**

Pursuant to RCW 36.70B.130 and KCC 15A.06, notice is hereby given that Kittitas County Community Development Services did on August 28, 2019 deny the Berlin Zoning Setback Variance, a request made by Dan Berlin, landowner, to reduce a 25 foot rear yard setback within the Residential zone to 15 feet to situate a single-family residence away from the adjoining property owner's existing single-family residence on the east side property line whose driveway is partially located on the subject property. The subject property is parcel # 088335 located at 50 Kitzbuhel Place in the Snoqualmie Pass Limited Area of More Intensive Rural Development, in Section 15, T22N, R11E, WM. Assessor's Map Number 22-11-15050-0005.
