The applicant has started to work with WDFW as indicated for an appropriate driveway crossing of the creek through an HPA permit. WDFW has no objections to the proposed setback on the non-streamside. On the creek side, in addition to a properly sized water crossing structure, WDFW has also give the guidance to preserve all riparian trees to the extent possible (to maintain shade and streambank stability) and where not possible, to replant streamside areas with shrubs or small trees that would be in appropriate to have near a residence.

- A. The applicant has applied for an access permit #AC-21-00139. This access will be constructed to current Kittitas County Road and Bridge Standards.
- B. Any grading over 100 cubic yards of material would require a grading permit from Public Works. Grading over 500 cubic yards would require engineered grading and stormwater plans to be submitted for review.
- C. Building footings, grading, overhangs and swinging doors cannot trespass into the neighboring parcel.
