SURVEY FORMAT

- 10-minute electronic survey in SurveyMonkey® (paper copies were available upon request)
- Maximum 45 questions
- Both modalities were available in English/Spanish
- Open September 10, 2021 - October 8, 2021

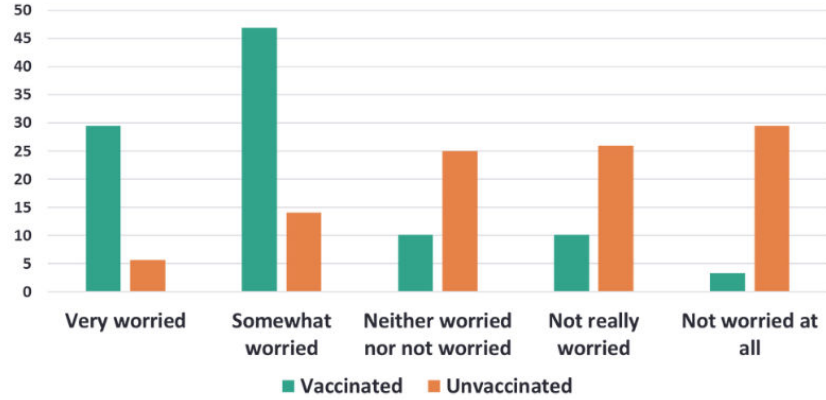
TARGET POPULATION

- Vaccinated and unvaccinated adults, special interest in parents/guardians of children 17 and under

RESPONSES

- For statistical significance, a total of 382 responses were needed, after the survey closed 1,493 were included in analysis.

How worried do you feel that you or someone in your immediate family might become seriously ill from COVID-19?



children **VACCINATED** for COVID-19 are about 30% more likely to also receive other recommended, routine vaccines



respondents **VACCINATED** for COVID-19 are about 60% more likely to have most or all of their friends/family vaccinated for COVID-19

TOP 3 WAYS YOU GET INFORMATION ABOUT VACCINES

**all responses*

- 1 Doctor, nurse, or clinic
- 2 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)
- 3 Local public health department, Kittitas County Public Health Department (KCPHD)

83.8% of **UNVACCINATED** respondents are unlikely or very unlikely to get vaccinated in the future

98.9% of **UNVACCINATED** parents have not vaccinated their 12-17 child or children

78.2% of **VACCINATED** parents have vaccinated their 12-17 child or children

TOP 3 REASONS FOR GETTING COVID-19 VACCINE FOR CHILDREN AGED 12-17

Having my child vaccinated is important for the health of others in my community

Getting the vaccine decreases the likelihood of my child/children getting infected with COVID-19

Vaccines are important for my child's health

TOP 3 REASONS FOR NOT GETTING COVID-19 VACCINE FOR CHILDREN AGED 12-17

I am waiting for more information about possible long-term side effects

I am worried about whether the vaccine is safe

My child did not want to be vaccinated
